History. The foundation stone of Naval Kindergarten School Port Blair was laid by Vice Admiral KL Kulkarni PVSM, FOC-in-C Eastern Naval Command, on January 13, 1974. The school commenced operations on November 4, 1974, and was inaugurated by Cmde PC Rajkhowa AVSM, Naval Officer-in-Charge of Andaman & Nicobar Islands. As the A&N Command expanded, a second branch of NKG Port Blair was established at Minnie bay and inaugurated by Vice Admiral Harinder Singh AVSM, Fortress Command A&N Islands, on March 12, 1999.
